**RULES FOR ELKS AND GUESTS AT THE
ELKS FAMILY RIVER PARK AND CAMPGROUND**

390 LODGE TRAIL

These Rules must be adhered to by all Elks and any guests at all times, whether or not an authorized Caretaker is present. Failure to comply with any requirement may be cause for the Elk to lose his/her Club and River Park privileges and cause for the member and/or non-complying guest to be asked to leave or be immediately removed from the premises.

ELKS LODGE #699 OR NONE OF ITS MEMBERS IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS, INJURIES, THEFT OR DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY WHICH MAY OCCUR ON THE PREMISES. NO LIFEGUARDS ARE PROVIDED AND SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.

1. Members of Salisbury Elks Lodge #699 are eligible to purchase a key to open campground gate and other locks at a price determined by the River Park and Campground Committee. The key will be functional for the current Lodge year April thru March. Each LESSEE will be provided two active key cards. NON-LESSEE ELK members are only allowed one active key card at a time, no spares will be sold. River Park key cards are not to be loaned to other members or guests. Lost River Park key cards will be replaced at the cost of current key card price. Key cards will only be available for purchase thru the Lodge Secretary.
2. Speed Limit through the park is 5 mph. All member and guest with golf carts will adhere to the River Park Golf Cart rules.
3. Members may utilize the park and camping facilities at no extra charge except as defined in the accompanying RATES FOR RIVER PARK CAMPING schedule or in the case of special entertainment events, which may take place at the park. All campsites are to be respected and their privacy acknowledged. **PLEASE WALK AROUND AND NOT THRU ANY OCCUPIED CAMPSITE.**
4. **CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES.** The playground area is open from dawn to dusk, or during a scheduled event in the pavilion and only until 10:00 pm. All children are the responsibility of their parents/guardian while at the park and fall under the same rules and regulations as members and guests. By allowing children to use the playground or other campground facilities, Parents/guardians assume any and all risk of injury to their children, or themselves, specifically waive any and all claims against Salisbury Elks Lodge #699, and will indemnify Salisbury Elks Lodge #699 from any and all liability due to them or their children's use of the playground or other campground facilities.
5. Parking is not reserved except at occupied campsites. Discretion should be used so as not to block traffic patterns, access to occupied campsites or interfere with others at the park. Boat trailers should be parked at the annex near the main entrance.

6. Boats may be launched at the concrete ramp and boats and trailers should be cleared from the area in a minimum amount of time to allow others to utilize the ramp and floating dock. **Watercraft are not to be tied at the dock for any excessive time and definitely not overnight. Violation of this rule could lead to suspension from the River Park.**
7. Shelter, rest rooms, showers, ice maker, permanent grills and tables are available and should be used in a caring and responsible manner to preserve the condition for everyone's continued use. The shelter may be reserved for private events or by the Lodge House Committee by clearing availability thru the River Park Committee Chairman.
8. Any trash generated is to be removed to the dumpster or taken off premises when a member or guest departs.
9. Campfires are permissible, unless banned by Fire Marshall in times of drought. No campfire is to be left unattended
10. Disorderly intoxication, use of illegal substances or any disruptive behavior is not permitted on the property. No alcohol is permitted in the possession of a minor at any time.
11. Any altercations resulting in physical violence is not permitted on the property and should be discouraged at all costs. The safety of the members and guests is the number one priority for the Salisbury Elks Lodge. If a member of the River Park committee, Board of Directors, Lodge Officer, the Caretaker, or Elks that are trying to resolve and contain the situation peacefully ask members/guests to vacate the area of an incident or volatile situation, or to return to their campsites until the situation is under control and safe, they are obligated to immediately leave, or risk being suspended from the use of the facilities. If the situation becomes too dangerous and a peaceful resolution is not possible without injury, 911 should be called and anyone not directly engaged in the event return immediately to their campsite. If the incident is at a camper, then anyone staying there not involved will go to the Pavilion until a safe space can be determined. Witnesses will be contacted later for their statements to be included in the incident report.
12. Loud music or other noise which may offend others is not permitted **AND VOLUMES MUST BE TOTALLY REDUCED NO LATER THAN 12:00 PM.**
13. LOUD MUSIC IS NOT PERMITTED ON THE PROPERTY. Functions and events authorized by the Salisbury Elks Lodge #699 may periodically include bands and music. Quiet time is 11:00 pm – 8:00 am Sunday – Thursday and 12:00 am through 8:00 am Friday and Saturday, except during Lodge sanctioned events held at the River Park. During Lodge events, Quiet Time shall start at the stated end time for each such Lodge event.
14. This is a family-oriented park. NUDITY OR PROFANITY ARE NOT PERMITTED. Parents are responsible for their children and their actions at all times.
15. NO PETS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED TO RUN FREE OR CAUSE NUISANCE. CURBING MUST BE AWAY FROM ANY ACTIVITY AREA AND POOPER-SCOOPERS MUST BE USED BY OWNERS IMMEDIATELY SHOULD THE NEED OCCUR.
16. FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE PROPERTY, except as authorized by Lodge for sanctioned events (ex. Turkey Shoot).

17. N.C. Fishing laws and licensing rules apply.
18. ANY tampering of electric meters, without the written consent of the BOD, will be a violation of the LESSEE's lease and will result in immediate termination of a lease.
19. LESSEE's found using electricity on an extended basis from another lot without written consent and permission from the BOD, will be given a warning for the first offense, and termination upon the second offense.
20. Use of the campground dumpster is for onsite River Park household garbage use only. Anyone found bringing in outside waste, or dumping building materials, broken furniture, or other non-household waste will be sent a warning for the first offense, and potential suspension of privileges thereafter. This includes the area surrounding the dumpster.
21. The River Park and Campground Committee is open for suggestions for continued improvements to make the Park facility the best it can be for all to use. Provide any suggestion you have in writing and give it to any committee member or drop it off at the Lodge Lounge.
